## Financial Updates (Roy/Jocelyn)

- Budget and Financials were reviewed. We still need to get some of our expenses in line with our projected revenue.
- Actuals as of June 13
  - Ticket income: \$25,725 (This is what is in our account Stripe pays out weekly, we're getting a \$5+ payment on Monday)
  - Expenses so far: \$21,096.23
  - Sponsorship income is starting to come in!

# 3. Conference Assistant

- We've updated the Conference Assistant position, and asked Kim center's former Assistant Manager, Roya to fill in.
